GUIDE FOR RECYCLING PRODUCTS IN THE CATERING SECTOR

How and where to recycle the materials used in the catering sector are two big questions that arise in the HoReCa sector.

In this guide we will show you in which bin to deposit our tablecloths and napkins and how to process them once used

We will also show you where to recycle other products used in the catering sector (cans, packaging, glass, blenders, aluminum, dishware...)







Contamination is one of the biggest problems we have on our hands, and each day it is getting worse. It is responsible for 7 million deaths per year (according to the latest W.H.O study), the disappearance of specie diversity, health deterioration in many people, global dimming, the cluttering of waterways, amongst other things.

Amongst all the actions we can take to combat contamination, there is one very easy method: recycling. Through this practice, we can reduce green-house gas emissions in the atmosphere.

When throwing away waste, we must make sure it is going into the appropriate bin-container. If we mix it, we are wasting everyone's time. Every time waste ends up in the wrong bin-container, the process comes to a stop.

In this document we are going to provide you with a simple guide so you can learn how to recycle products used in the catering sector and in which bin-containers they should be deposited.



THE YELLOW BIN-CONTAINER

Cans, cartons, and plastic packaging



WE CAN RECYCLE

METAL PACKAGING

Aluminum cans, aluminum trays, aerosols, metallic jar lids and bottle caps.

CARTON

Juice, milk, wine, milkshake, broth, gazpacho, etc.

PLASTIC PACKAGING

Water, soft-drink, and milk bottles. Cleaning products. Shampoo, cologne, shower gel. Frozen-good bags. Yogurt and butter containers. Styrofoam containers, plastic wrap, snack bags, and plastic bags.

*For more effective recycling, empty the packages well and reuse plastic shopping bags to take them to the bin-container.

LA PAJARITA PRODUCTS RECYCLABLE IN THIS BIN-CONTAINER:

NEWTEX TABLECLOTHS

Being made from 100% polypropylene. | 50 gr/m2 spun-bonded can be recycled with no problems in this bin-container, allowing this material to be put to another use.



WE CAN NOT RECYCLE

CD-ROM | BLENDERS | WORK ATTIRE | UTENSILS GLASS BOTTLES | NAPKINS

Never place aluminum foil, cartons, diapers, dirty napkins and paper towels, or grease-stained cardboard and paper in the blue bin-container.



THE BLUE BIN-CONTAINER

Cardboard and paper packaging



WE CAN RECYCLE

CARDBOARD PACKAGING

All the cardboard packaging we use is recyclable: cookie, cereal, frozen-good boxes,egg cartons, etc.

ALL TYPES OF PAPERS

Newspapers, books, magazines, order pads, paper bags.

*You can reuse paper bags to store cardboard packaging, well-folded, and take it all to the blue bin-container.



WE CAN NOT RECYCLE

OLD CLOTHES | DIRTY NAPKINS | TOYS ALUMINUM FOIL | CARTONS | DIAPERS

Never place aluminum foil, cartons, diapers, dirty napkins and paper towels, or grease-stained cardboard and paper in the blue bin-container.



THE GREEN BIN-CONTAINER

Glass bottles and jars



WE CAN RECYCLE

GLASS CONTAINERS

In this bin-container we can place any glass bottle or (jam or canned) jar.

WE CAN NOT RECYCLE

LIGHTBULBS | PIECES OF DISH-WARE BROKEN GLASS PLATES | FLUORESCENT LIGHTBULBS

Never place lightbulbs, fluorescent lightbulbs, porcelain, ceramics, windows or mirrors, glasses, wine-glasses, or caps, corks, or metallic lids from glass containers, etc. in the green bin-container.



ORGANIC BIN-CONTAINER

Organic waste



WE CAN RECYCLE

FOOD LEFTOVERS

All of the biodegradable food leftovers, such as shells and fruit skins, bits of meats and fish, vegetables, coffee grains, tea-bags, etc.

BIO-DEGRADABLE AND COMPOSTABLE WASTE

We can place waste, such as grease-stained paper and cardboard, small pieces of vegetation, cork and sawdust pluggers.

*The waste from these containers are brought to composting plants so that the waste placed in them can be turned into compost.

LA PAJARITA PRODUCTS RECYCLABLE IN THIS BIN-CONTAINER:

ORGANIC AND BIO-DEGRADABLE AIR-LAID

The material used in the production of our Air-laid Bio products are specifically designed to be turned into compost by recycling them in the appropriate bin-container.

PAPER TABLECLOTHS AND NAPKINS

Our paper tablecloths and napkins, made from 100% cellulose, can also be recycled in this bin-container. Also, our 37gr tablecloths are also bio-degradable.

WE CAN NOT RECYCLE

CANS | GLASS BOTTLES | BLENDERS SANITARY CLOTHS | HEALTH CARE WASTE

Never place swept-up dust, cigarette butts and ashes, diapers, sanitary napkins, tampons, cotton ear swabs, baby-wipes, band-aids, cotton, adhesive tape, bandages, gauze, etc in the bio-degradable bin-container.

OTHER WASTE

All waste residues that are not containers, or that are not collected by the local municipality, should be placed in this container, such as is the case with diapers.

We can also place waste, such as old pots and pans, plates and utensils, window glass, plastic and metal objects not used in packaging, etc., in this container.

*When you are not sure where to place something, ask your town-hall or bring it to a municipal drop-off center.
