

That the products manufactured in its mill are based on 100 % recycled fibre.

Said products are mainly used for bag making and masking paper under the reference

K80 & K90 and are not considered harmful to health or potentially dangerous to the environment since the mill's production process follows the guidelines established by the current legislation which regulates food contact materials.
